



PARENT CONTRACT

I, (We), the undersigned parent(s) or guardian(s) do hereby acknowledge and agree to First Assembly Christian School's (FACS) criteria for enrollment/re-enrollment of my child.

Enrollment/re-enrollment will be contingent upon:

- 1. My Child's Performance:** I understand my child is expected to score at or above the 50th percentile (Total Battery score) on standardized tests. I understand also that my child is expected to maintain an average of 75% or above in each subject area for the school year. If my child's average falls below this standard, I agree to provide remedial services for my child based on the school's recommendations.
- 2. Financial Accounting:** If any tuition or fee is over two weeks late, or we have a record of more than two returned checks per year, the child will be subject to dismissal. Official student transcripts will not be released to a new school if the student has an unpaid account balance.
- 3. Discipline:** We ask that parents cooperate with teachers' requests for conferences and support recommendations made by the teacher or administrative office. A child will usually be allowed three disciplinary incidents requiring involvement with the administrative office. The first requires a conference with an administrator, or time-out in the office and a note to the parents. The second visit will require a conference with the administrator and the parent at the time of the visit to the office. The third visit would require that the parent take the child home for the day. A fourth return may require dismissal on the part of the child. **However**, the nature and impact of individual disciplinary incidents may warrant more serious and immediate action, as deemed appropriate by the administration. Therefore, disciplinary action may not always be progressive or may not be a specific incident listed in the school handbook. In the event that the teacher or administrative office reaches an impasse with the parents, continued enrollment will be at the discretion of the administration.
- 4. Parent Participation:** Parents are expected to volunteer with the school. We need your active participation and invite you to find your place of service at FACS.
- 5. Learning Disabilities and Special Needs:** Because of limited staffing and resources, FACS cannot provide academic or behavioral accommodations in the classroom beyond the scope of our program. Parents with students requiring accommodations, as recommended by psychological or educational testing, **HEREBY WAIVE AND RELEASE** the school from the responsibility to provide these accommodations. The parent must also provide a signed agreement that they will provide the necessary supplemental services at their own expense. If supplemental services within the scope of our program are required, the school will review, on a case-by-case basis, whether or not the school can meet the needs of the child. Students requiring accommodations will be limited to two per classroom. If during the course of the year a child is recommended for testing or identified as having a learning disability or attention deficit disorder, the guidelines stated above will apply.
- 6.** The school reserves the right to dismiss any student not cooperating with the educational process and/or whose parents or legal guardians refuse to cooperate with the school.
